GUIDELINES

- The Department reserves the right to determine the compensation to be made based on the available resources.
- Applications must be sent to <u>officialdcsr@gmail.com</u>
- Only applicants that meet the said criteria may apply.
- Only applicants affected by cancellation of projects/sporting events as a result of Covid-19 from 16 March to 30 June 2020
- The relief payments will only be made to athletes, coaches, technical personnel and other beneficiaries after the date of the cancelled project/sporting event would have been held
- Letter of support from the government department/entity or federation is mandatory
- All applicants should have registered Cooperatives, NGO, NPO, NBO, NPC, NPI and Companies that are eligible to apply.
- Tax Clearance Certificate and proof of residence is compulsory in all submission to be made by the athletes, coaches and technical personnel
- For cancelled sporting events, a statement of cancellation or letter of cancellation is mandatory.
- Permanent or employees on a fixed contract are not eligible for this Relief. They must explore other Relief intervention available to Business and Labour.
- Provision of false information will be treated as fraud and dealt with through appropriate Criminal Justice System
- Excluded from the relief are national and international athletes
- The department will determine the threshold for the relief
- Closing date for submission is Friday, 5 June 2020 at 16:15
